Tailored career assistance

- · explore and understand local job and training opportunities
- complete a stand-out online job application
- meet local employers and learn about their expectations

At the end of this section of the program you will have:

- a professional resume and cover letter suited to your job search
- increased digital skills, including using email and Microsoft Word
- enhanced interview and communication skills that will help you during your job search and future employment
- · a new network of contacts, including employers and peers

Take a moment to reflect on what you have learned. In the next few days your Facilitator will meet with you and your Employment Consultant to discuss and celebrate your achievements so far. We'll also chat about your next steps for pursuing employment and other opportunities.
